A summary of the Plan.

Chippenham Without is a wholly rural parish and the Vision of the Neighbourhood Plan is to preserve the rural character of the area through supporting farming as the principal economic activity, linked to the encouragement of small local businesses centred largely on local business parks.

The Vision envisages:

- preservation of the historic features within the parish,
- only encouraging new building that meets the needs of local residents and businesses,
- protecting and fostering the health of the area's natural environment,
- retaining the Parish's current identity,
- being a green lung for our near neighbour, Chippenham.

The purpose of the Plan.

A Neighbourhood Plan is a planning statement by the residents of what they would like the planning principles to be governing planning policy and future development within their local area.

The Neighbourhood Plan runs until 2036 and exists within a hierarchy of planning policy document and is subordinate to the county-wide Wiltshire Local Plan (also known as the Core Strategy) and national planning policies. The Neighbourhood Plan is a clear statement of local preferences, and it carries its due weight when local planning decisions are made.

The process.

This draft Plan may be modified by the Steering Group upon consideration of the comments received from this consultation and the final Plan will then be sent for approval to Wiltshire Council and the appointed Neighbourhood Plan Inspector, followed by a Referendum of the Parish. We need to demonstrate engagement in the process by the local community hence the importance of completing and returning this form.
