Wiltshire Council will notify the Council of the timescale to submit their Precept Requirement for 2026/2027. This will be before the Council next meets and in these circumstances the Council considers their Budget and required Precept at this Council Meeting. The Council will be advised of their new Tax Base but one can assume that it will not be significantly different from this year. The Band D property charge is based upon the Council Precept Requirement divided by the Tax Base. Last year, with the Precept being £12,000.00, it resulted in a £130.36 Band D property charge.

Members will recall that the Council increased their budget in 2021/2022 to £12,000.00 and has retained that figure for the following 4 years without using any of the existing capital funds held. To accommodate rising revenue costs and potential capital spending, without using any of the existing capital funds held, the Council may wish to consider raising the Precept Requirement. A projected Receipts & Payments Schedule for the year is attached for guidance.

There are known commitments before year-end and some potential spending (shown in red). The Council has taken over no local role in replacing Wiltshire Council lost services and unless other spending is required then the overall Council spending could be around £10,842.81 and below predicted budget. (see attached) The Council is asked to consider their budget for Year 2026/2027 and Precept Requirement to be able to notify Wiltshire Council within the timescale. (For Decision)
